\$10. Rabies Vaccinations are required at the time of surgery if your pet is not already vaccinated.

This Clinic is for King William and King and Queen County residents ONLY!

Proof of residency required

Article 3.2-6521 of the Code of Virginia requires owners of dogs and cats 4 months or older to have the animal currently vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian.
