4-H Camp 2022

Virginia Cooperative Extension 4-H centers play an important role in educating the next generation. Virginia's 4-H camping program is recognized throughout the nation as a leader in 4-H camping programs. Each of the six Virginia 4-H Educational Centers achieved and maintains American Camp Association (ACA) accreditation. As defined by the American Camp Association, organized camping is "a sustained experience that provides a creative, recreational, and educational opportunity in group living in the outdoors. It utilizes trained leadership and the resources of natural surroundings to contribute to each camper's mental, physical, social, and spiritual growth." (ACA, 2019) Since 4-H camping is educationally focused, it is recognized as a delivery method for 4-H programming.

Virginia 4-H & NRA Shooting Education Camp

August 7-11, 2022

This camp is for youth ages 12-16 (age as of Aug. 8, 2022) with an interest and/or experience with shooting sports. Camp includes safety education, fundamentals and theory, marksmanship instruction and competitive shoot. Cost for Shotgun or muzzleloader - \$330 Archery, rifle or pistol \$310. 4-H Inbound States' 4-H Exchange

Would you be interested in hosting a student or adult chaperone for 4 weeks this summer? Virginia 4-H is a partner with States' 4-H International Exchange and we can make that happen.

The basics & requirements of the inbound program:

- Program runs July 22-24 through August 16-18, 2022
- Japanese, Korean or Taiwanese delegates 12-18 years old
- Youth have a range of English language abilities.
- Host family receives no stipend to host a delegate.
- To host a delegate, a family must have a child who is 9+ years old.
- Families will be matched with a delegate of the same gender who is within 3 years of the host youth's age.
- Families without youth can host adult chaperones.
- Delegates are here to experience every day American life. No special activities need to be planned.
- Virginia 4-H will provide a host family orientation.


