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To whom it may concern:

Be advised that the Manitoba Vehicle Weights and Dimensions Steering Committee has signed and approved a new interim permit policy standard to increase the overall length of A and C Trains from 25.0 metres to 26.0 metres. The new interim policy is currently in effect as of June 1, 2026. Please note that Manitoba Transportation and Infrastructure intend to include this change in the Manitoba Vehicle Weights and Dimensions on Classes of Highways Regulation (MR 155/2018) under the Highway Traffic Act. After MR 155/2018 is amended to include the new length of these configurations, motor carriers will not be required to get a permit to operate these configurations legally in Manitoba.

The purpose of this permit policy standard change is to support harmonization efforts with other western provinces who already allow this overall length for A and C Trains. The Province of Manitoba is a member of both the National Vehicle Weights and Dimensions Task Force and the Western Canada Vehicle Weights and Dimensions Task Force with a common goal of harmonizing vehicle weights and dimensions among member jurisdictions.

Annual permits for A and C Trains with a 26.0 metres total length configuration can now be issued through Manitoba's online permitting system ([MB MOOVES](#)) or by calling the Permit Services Office at 204-945-3961 (Winnipeg) or toll free at 1-877-812-0009.
