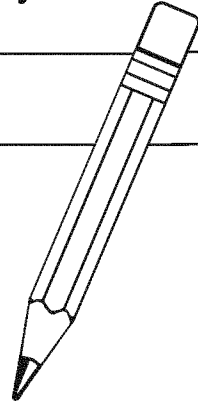


Whatever mission Saul sent him on, David was so successful that Saul gave him a high rank in the army.

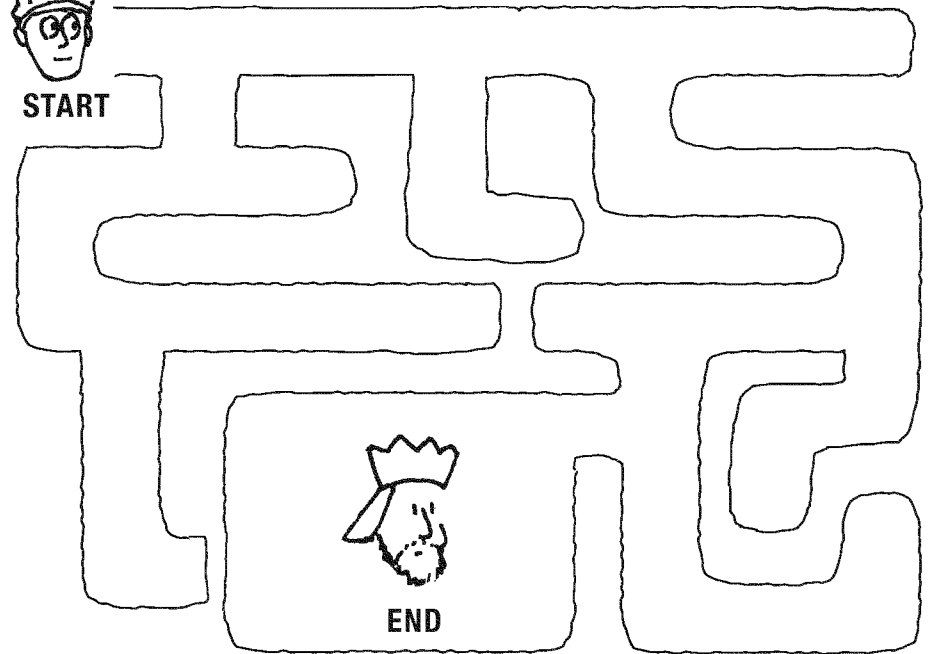
David and Jonathan

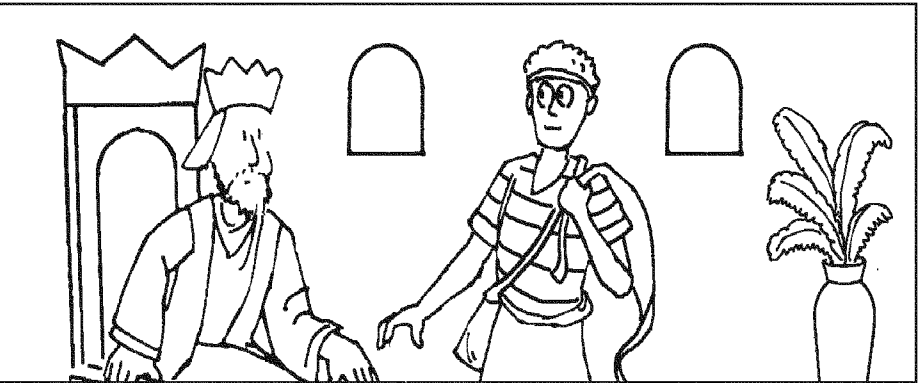
