PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Recently, a lot of questions have been raised about what "Italian Descent" means for membership in the AAIC. I want to address those questions and dispel any rumors. "Italian Descent" is the hereditary derivation or lineage of an individual. A lineal descendant is a person in the direct line of descent from an ancestor, legally referred to as "issue." This includes anyone who can trace their lineage straight down the family tree from a specific individual. The most straightforward examples are a person's children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, etc. "Italian Descent" for purposes of Club membership cannot be established by DNA tests, rather, you must be able to establish your Italian lineage through specific family relationships and/or a family tree. The reason for this is because your DNA test reflects probability, not a precise family tree. That is how autosomal DNA tests work.

You may not know that DNA ancestry testing is not static — updates can change your results. There is no specific gene for being "Italian." If you submitted DNA tests with different companies, your results would likely be different. Additionally, your ethnicity estimate is not "final." As DNA testing companies grow their databases, your report can change. The science behind ancestry testing evolves, and so does your profile. In addition, some nearby regions share DNA traits. That overlap is not a glitch; it is just a part of shared human migration. That is why ancestry DNA tests often group genetically close populations together. It is not an exact science and that is why we do not use DNA tests for membership. Please feel free to contact me or the Membership Committee if you have any questions.

The Arizona American Italian Club was established in 1957, long before DNA tests were invented. Our Italian heritage is important, and we maintain that heritage through our rich traditions. We have a long history of honoring our culture. The Vendemmia, or grape harvest, is one of the most important agricultural events in Italy, and September is the peak month for harvest festivals. From Tuscany's rolling vineyards to the hills of Piedmont and Sicily, wine regions come alive in Italy in September with celebrations that honor the grape harvest and the process of winemaking. This month let us raise a glass together at the Club!!


