Service Credit Union Launches Loan to Offer iBOT Mobility Device to Members



Service Credit Union has partnered with Mobius Mobility to make its iBOT® Personal Mobility Device (PMD), a revolutionary mobility product, more accessible to thousands of prospective users.

Developed by inventor Dean Kamen and manufactured by Mobius Mobility in Manchester, NH, the iBOT® is a breakthrough product for people with disabilities. The robotic, multi-modal iBOT® is customized to each user and includes features such as the four-wheel-drive to traverse sand, snow, mud, and other terrains. The iBOT® gives the user the ability to climb curbs and stairs, and rise up to interact with the world at eye level.

For many years, Service Credit Union has worked with veteran-focused nonprofits that provide grants for iBOT®s, but the organization wanted to make iBOT®s available to a wider swath of the population. That's why Service CU teamed with Mobius to support potential users in making the purchase of the device more attainable.

Drew Bairstow Named Cooperative Middle School Principal



The Exeter Region Cooperative School Board voted unanimously to hire Drew Bairstow, of Dover, as the new principal of the Cooperative Middle School (CMS). With 21 years of experience as an educator, Bairstow, who is currently the principal at Lincoln Street School in Exeter, assumes his new role as CMS principal on July 1.

As CMS principal, Bairstow will be responsible for providing leadership in all aspects of instructional programming and teaching practices for student learning, continuing strong relationships with parents and the community involvement, and managing the operations of the school including a budget, staffing, etc. He will also have the unique opportunity of reconnecting with many past students from Lincoln Street School who are now at CMS.

Prior to serving as principal of Lincoln Street School, Bairstow was principal at the Fred C. Underhill School in Hooksett for four years and assistant principal at Hooksett Memorial School for three years. Before his educational leadership positions, Bairstow fulfilled various roles in multiple school districts in New Hampshire as a middle school reading and language arts teacher, special education instructional assistant, and an English teacher in Thailand.
