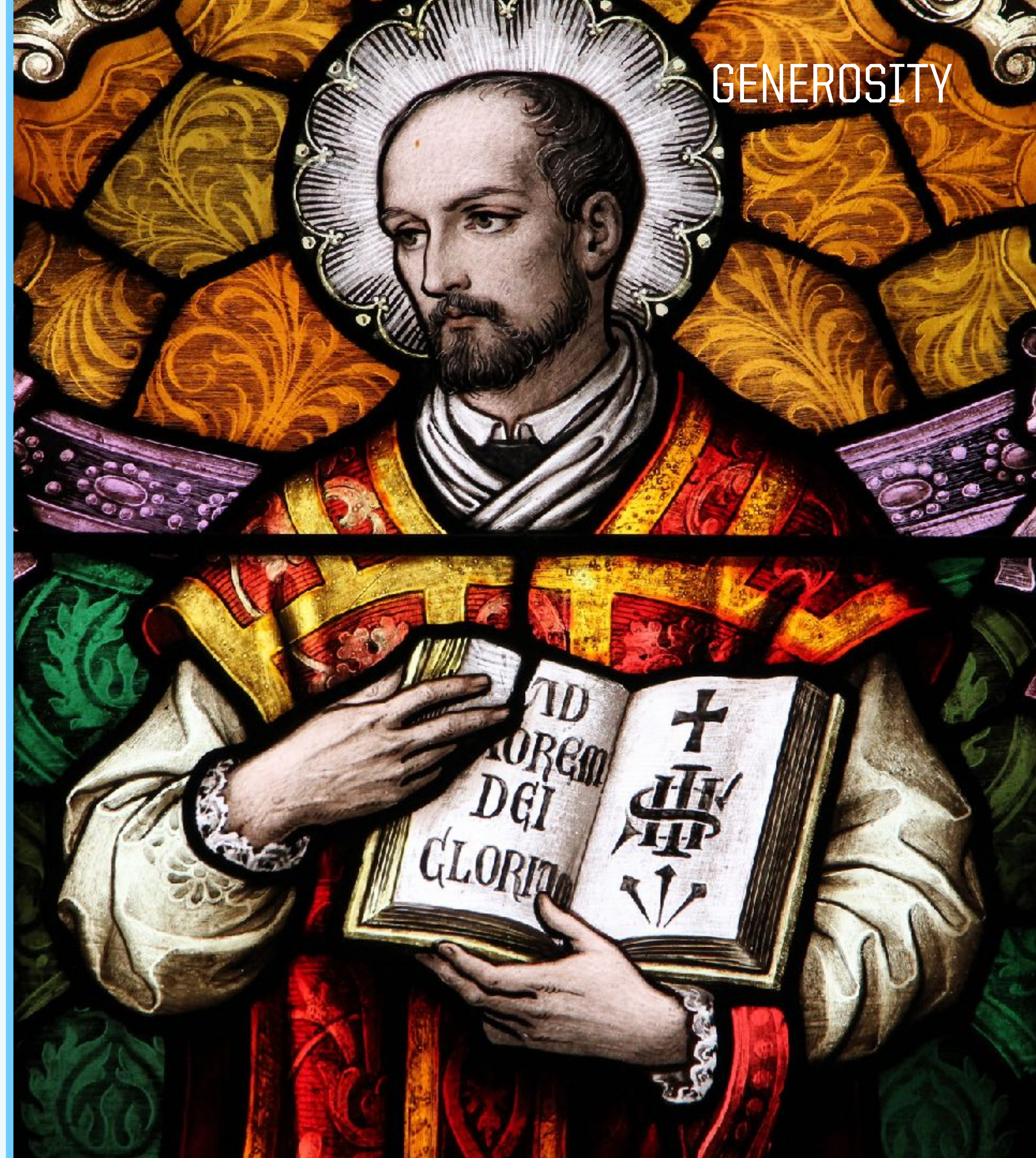

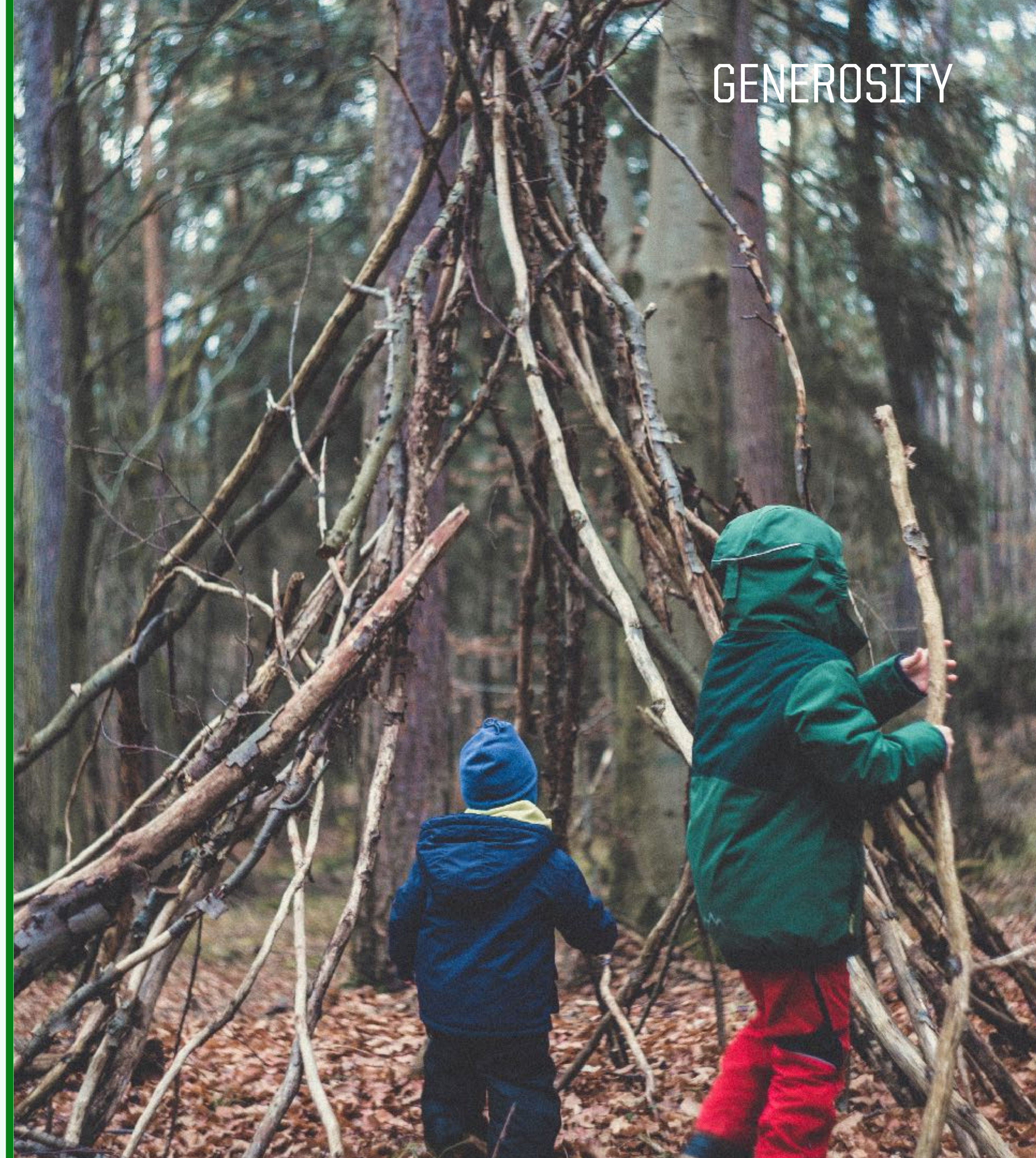

Be with us again

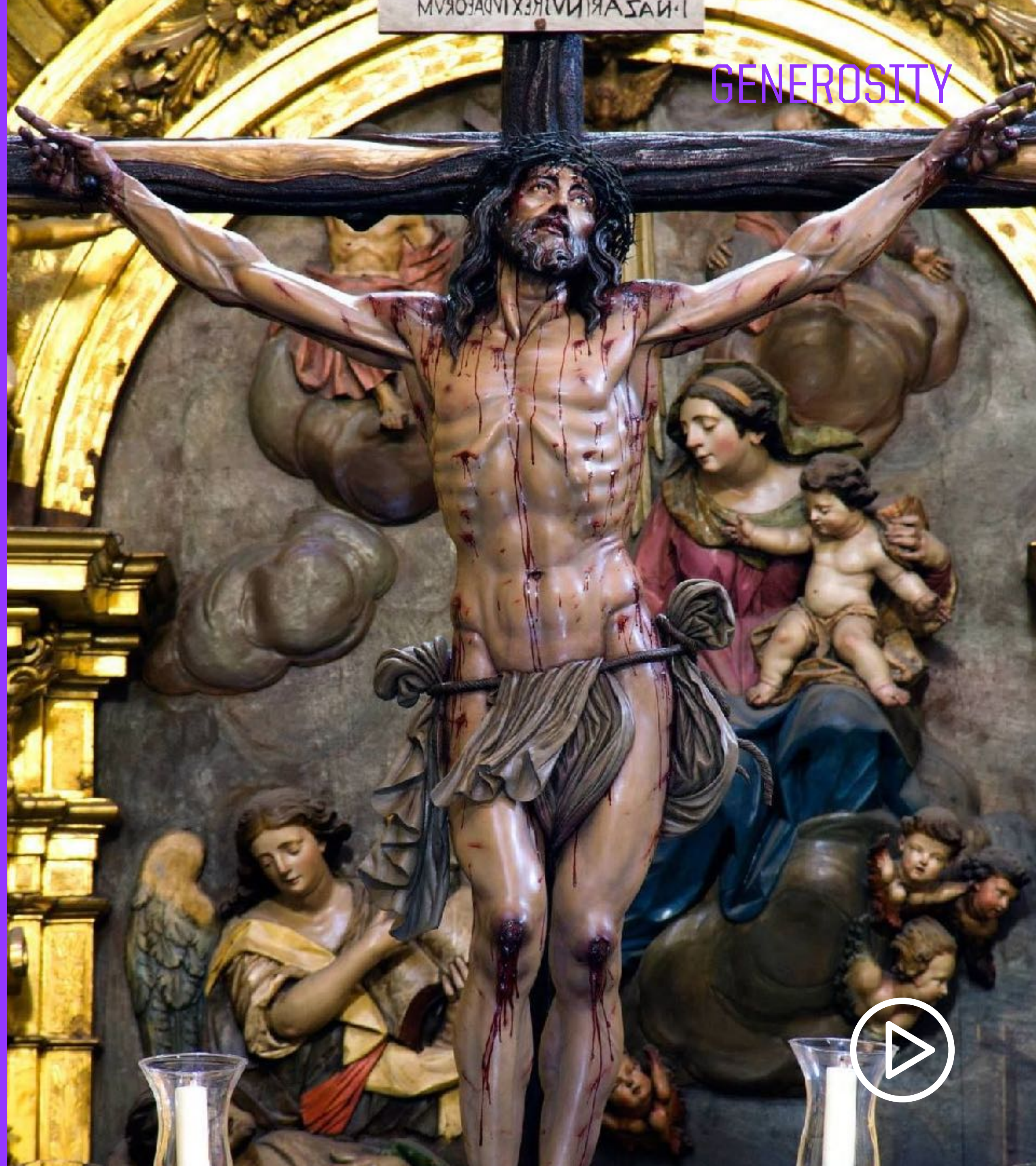
