

Financial Aid Qualifications and Form

Students ages 2–18 and adults in the NPAC and/or PULSE classes, programs, lessons, etc. are eligible to apply for financial aid. Financial aid is determined based on family size/number of dependents and the total annual household gross income must not exceed 50% of the state median income as determined by the DOJ.

Family Size	Average Annual Household Median Income
1	\$55,681
2	\$69,884
3	\$75,057
4*	\$89,206

^{*4} or more will be determined off of the family size of 4

If applicants meet these requirements they are eligible for full financial assistance.

Individuals who are awarded NPAC financial aid are limited to one class, one lesson and /or one musical theater production per season. Enrollment in any other classes, lessons, musical theater productions will not receive financial aid. Children and teens receiving financial aid for summer classes are limited to one weeklong session per summer.

Applicants are expected to attend class regularly and participate in all class activities.

Financial aid is based upon availability and is not guaranteed.

How to Apply

- 1. Complete and fill out all the online Financial Aid form <u>HERE</u> 6 weeks before the class, lesson, production, etc. is scheduled to begin.
- 2. Submit a copy of your most recent documentation of income from all contributing adults in the household. Acceptable forms of income documentation include pay stubs, tax returns, social security disbursement, child support order, disability disbursement, retirement disbursement, and/or 1099.
- 3. Agree to and sign the Terms and Conditions Agreement (an electronic signature is acceptable).
- 4. Send Email to Info@naplesperformingartscenter.com to notify you have submitted a Financial Aid Application for review.

Financial information will remain confidential and will be shredded and disposed of after determining eligibility.
