1. COVID Accelerator Effect: What once may have taken years of R&D, meetings, strategizing, planning, etc. is now being done in months. What once took months is now taking weeks. Long-delayed initiatives have suddenly been rolled out at scale overnight. Businesses will be forced to reengineer their entire operations, supply chains and workforces to prevent future disruptions from putting them out of existence.
