- Active Shooter Table Top Drill completed on campus with officers from the 24th police district and Sentinel Security
- Stop the Bleed training has started – all staff will receive this training now and on-going as part of their annual CPR re-training
- Stop the Bleed Kits (containing tourniquets and wound care supplies) have been placed throughout the campus alongside the AED machines
- Active Threat presentation/training with members of the Safety Advisory Team from the Chicago Police Department being held for all Misericordia staff
- Policy/procedure for Misericordia Campus Wide Response to Conway DT Evacuation has been developed
- Policy/procedure for Misericordia Campus Wide Response to after hours event at CDS/DT program site has been developed
- Contents of Emergency Boxes (containing pertinent campus information for police and fire departments and located throughout the campus) has been updated
- Security cameras being added to Thome and Ridge reception areas
- Campus lockdown procedures updated
- CILA homes all receiving Ring Doorbells for increased security
- Campus being evaluated for addition of blue pull stations – similar to pull stations for fire alarms, but these would go directly to the police
- Armed security now on campus 24 hours a day
- Chain of Command Protocol updated
- Emergency Preparedness Succession Plan updated
- Organizational chart updated
