Anderson County Schools

Anderson School District 1

School breakfast and lunch will begin being distributed on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, at limited sites. Breakfast and lunch will be bagged and distributed in the car line on Monday-Friday during the school closure.

Requirements to Receive These Services:

- The person must be a senior citizen, aged 60 or older or the person must be taking the meal to a senior citizen and be a resident of Anderson County.
- Must provide name, address, and phone number of person receiving the meals at pick up
- Each individual must show a state issued ID
- Only 2 meal packs are allowed per car
- Individuals will be given 5 meals at the time of pickup and will only be permitted one pickup per week

Pickens County School District

SDPC is offering breakfast and lunch for *anyone* under the age of 18 (and special needs adults up to age 21) on school days (Mon.-Fri.). Each child must be present to receive a meal.

Starting March 31, Tuesdays during the school closure will be “Twofer Tuesdays” for meal delivery and pickup. Meals for 2 days (Tuesday and Wednesday) will both be delivered on Tuesday.

Beginning April 13, food service will begin delivering three days a week: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Our food service sites at schools and churches will follow the same schedule as above, and will continue to be open from 10am-1pm. We will continue to make adjustments to bus routes on a weekly basis.

Bus Delivery:

School buses will travel to their morning and afternoon stops carrying meals beginning at 10 a.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Lunch and breakfast will be delivered together. Estimated times of delivery for the following locations can be found on the school website as we work to get them added for all of the zones.

Bus routes will be updated weekly:

Daniel Area (Clemson/Central/Six Mile)
Easley Area
Liberty Area
Pickens Area (includes Dacusville)

If the time when a student needs to pick up their meal conflicts with a class time, please inform the teacher. Keeping our students fed is a top priority, and our teachers will work with students to make sure basic needs are met first.

If you have questions about a bus arriving on time, please call your area bus office. **Any child, whether they ride a bus or not, is allowed to get a meal at any bus stop. If you need a meal, just look for a yellow bus!**

Oconee County Schools

Any child, 18 years old and younger, can receive breakfast and lunch on each day that would have been a scheduled school day throughout the school closure. **Children do not have to be enrolled in Oconee County Schools to receive meals.**

Effective March 23, meals will be served on Mondays (2 lunches and 2 breakfasts), Wednesdays (2 lunches and 2 breakfasts), and Fridays (1 lunch and 1 breakfast). If closure is extended, meals will be available on any day that would have been a school day. Children must be present to receive a meal; they cannot be picked up by families without children. Meals will be “grab and

go" style; students will not be able to eat meals at the site. Meals can be picked up at any school location (except HCC and Oconee Academy) at 12:00-1:30pm.
