Exact Path by Edmentum


Exact Path is an online learning program that personalizes instruction in reading, language arts, and math for students in grades K–12.

Using your child's MAP test results in math and English, Exact Path creates a custom learning path aligned to grade-level standards and designed to meet them where they are.

As your child works through their path, they'll track progress and earn rewards along the way. After each set of skills, a short Progress Check shows what they've learned and helps decide whether to review or move ahead.
