RAILROAD CROSSING CLOSURE AT BLUE HERON BLVD. IN RIVIERA BEACH BEGINS SUNDAY, DECEMBER 17

(December 11, 2023) – The railroad crossing at Blue Heron Blvd. in Riviera Beach in Palm Beach County will close at 7 a.m., Sunday, December 17 and will remain closed until 7 p.m., Wednesday, December 20.

The closure is necessary while Brightline completes crossing rehabilitation of the existing track to repair rails and roadway profiles over the tracks to improve ride quality. Motorists should proceed with extra caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs, speed limits and other signage. Detour information is below.

Detour Information

- Westbound Blue Heron Blvd. traffic will be directed to travel south on US-1 to 13th St., travel west on 13th St. to Old Dixie Hwy. and travel north on Old Dixie Hwy. to Blue Heron Blvd.
- Eastbound Blue Heron Blvd. traffic will be directed to travel south on Old Dixie Hwy to 13th St., travel east on 13th St. to US-1 and travel north on US-1 to access Blue Heron Blvd.
- *Eastbound Blue Heron Blvd. traffic wishing to access the Riviera Beach Water Treatment Plant, City Hall and the Fire Department* will be directed to travel south on Old Dixie Hwy to 13th St., travel east on 13th St. to US-1 and travel north on US-1 to access westbound Blue Heron Blvd.
