Summer Students Required for Brandon Area

Manitoba Beef & Forage Initiatives is looking for summer students for our beef and forage research and demonstration farm located near Brandon MB. The positions to be filled are Research Assistants, and are responsible for fulfilling the duties listed in the job description below.

Duties

The bulk of the job will be linked to assisting where needed in the daily management of beef and forage applied-research trials. Listed below are some of the expected duties:

- o Collecting forage, soil and manure samples;
- o Operating large and small farm equipment;
- o Sorting and moving cattle;
- o Maintaining cattle handling facilities, including electric fencing;
- o Heavy lifting;
- o Data entry and record keeping of trial activities and livestock performance.

General farm labour, farm yard maintenance, using power tools, and towing trailers.

Term of employment

The summer student will be employed by MBFI on a full-time basis commencing in April or early May and ending with the beginning of school in September of 2018. Part time work may also be available from September 2018 to April 2019 depending on the situation.

Hours of work

The hours of work are dependent on activities requiring your assistance but are generally 40 hours per week. Evening and weekend work may be required during busy periods.

Requirements

This position requires a valid Class 5 licence and the ability to travel to and from the MBFI sites located within 12 miles of Brandon. A Class 3 licence is an asset. The applicant must be a registered student at the time of application or enrolled for the September 2018 school year.
