MFGA held a very successful AGM at Brandon's Victoria Inn February 9, 2018 to time with the Manitoba Beef Producers AGM. Nearly 40 MFGA delegates bounced out of bed for pastries and coffee for a 7:00 am start on a chilly February morning that saw Minister Eichler address the crowd by highlighting the importance of forages and grasslands to Manitoba and the important work and role of MFGA.
