Northwest ISD offers FREE Developmental Screenings for children 6 months old to five years old (not yet in Kindergarten) if you live within the NISD attendance boundaries.

FACT:

Early detection and intervention will increase the likelihood that a delay will improve.



What is a developmental screening?

Developmental screening is a quick look to see if your child's development is on track. Early identification of and intervention with any developmental concerns will help a child to be the best he or she can be!
