Pearl Necklace: Twenty-to-22-millimeter white baroque fresh water pearls were hand selected to create this 27" necklace that artistically combines ten to twelve millimeter round freshwater pearls in an eye-catching design. The pearls have been hand knotted on the finest silk cord. A magnetic clasp set with a pave of man-made stones completes the necklace.



Pearl Earrings: Created with two white high luster baroque fresh water pearls that are separated by a diamond encrusted rondelle. French ear wires set with multiple small natural diamonds complete the pair of hand designed earrings.
