



Hello. We would like to express our gratitude to CFA for the help rendered to our cattery. Few people understand what happens at the start of a war, especially if no one was expecting it.

We had many cats and kittens, we had a standard supply for 2 weeks, as for a cattery. From the first 3-5 days of the war, when we were shocked by what was happening, we tried to work out exit routes in case the enemy came to our region, prepared carriers for cats, sought shelters, stocked up on gasoline, hid from shellings... then we began to look for additional supplies for our cats and kittens - and they were almost nowhere to be found.

There was no food, no filler for litter boxes - nothing at all! It was also almost impossible to order online, as the logistics in the country were broken. We bought everything we found and began to wait what to do next, focusing on the situation at the front I... but the stocks were inexorably coming to an end and we soon realized that we had them for about 5 days and there was nowhere else to take them... really nowhere.

Help came to us from CFA, for whom we are very grateful - the problem with dry food was solved. In fact, it's hard to imagine that today you can buy everything you need, and suddenly there's nothing tomorrow... it's just not there and you don't know when it will be... Thank God, we managed to survive this difficult moment with your help.
