## **SUMMARY**

There are currently 8,356 open positions in the 10-county region with over 83K open positions within 60 miles. Demand Projections are updated Monthly and 2024 Q2 shows an almost 3K job increase in our 5 year demand and an almost 4K increase in our ten year demand for talent compared to last quarter. Registered Nurses has taken the top spot with most job posting at 651, with Frist-Line Supervisors of Retail Sales Workers sitting at 348 postings.

The labor force participation rate for Kentucky was 57.3% in March of 2021 and has increased slightly to 57.6% as of the most recent date from the Federal Reserve. This places Kentucky as the seventh worst state which is an improvement of being the third worst since the Summer of 2020.

In the next ten years, the region will need over 4,000 entry level manufacturing workers and 1,702 Registered Nurses. The region will also need 4,085 Material Handlers, 2,722 Semi-Truck Drivers, 690 Welders, and 850 Industrial Machinery Mechanics. In addition to that, South Central Kentucky is also going to see demand for many new engineers including 393 new industrial engineers, 167 mechanical engineers, 114 civil engineers, and 86 electrical engineers.
