



YOUR NEIGHBORS CLOAK: LOOKING TO DONATE?

UPDATED (November 11th, 2020) Due to Coronavirus/ Covid-19 Pandemic we are continuously reevaluating our donation procedure. During this time where we are in a change of seasons, the need for clothing is rising. We must also strive to keep our volunteers safe. Therefore, we are currently accepting limited items:

- Unused socks and underwear for children/youth, men, and women.
- Unused thermal underwear for children/youth, men and women.
- Winter coats, sweaters, hats, gloves, mittens/gloves for children/youth, men and women.
- Tennis shoes and winter boots for children/youth, men and women.
- Blankets and fleece throws for children/youth, men and women.
- Toiletry items that are accepted: toilet paper, soap, deodorant, razors, toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss, mouthwash, shampoo, body lotion, feminine products.

Additional household items will only be collected on a 'need' basis. Please check with Deacon Barbara Maxwell at deacon.stluke.cleveland@gmail.com before making a donation of other items.

At this time, we are not accepting clothing items outside of what is listed above. We ask that clothing be sorted and labeled by gender and age if possible. (For example: Boys shoes, Women's coats)

All drop offs must be coordinated with a St. Luke's Staff member. We cannot accept items left at our door. We must also know from whom the items are coming from.

At this time, we cannot accept spring, fall, or summer clothing or business apparel.

Keep in mind: St. Luke's ministers to a diverse population from various cultures. Make sure that donations meet the needs of all people despite cultural backgrounds. All donations should be something that you yourself would wear (not damaged or unclean).

Your Neighbors Cloak currently distributes clothing every Wednesday from 5-6pm. Volunteers are welcome to join us distribute clothing, or to sort clothing in our ministry building beginning at 2pm on Wednesdays. All volunteers during this time must wear a mask and gloves (we can provide this if it is needed).
