

Educational Trips to the Mayland Earth to Sky Park

Planetarium

Field trips run as a 2-hour trip in the planetarium. Start by learning about the dark skies from the International Dark Sky Association. Watch a trailer for a show to come back and catch and then the feature film. Then take a quick "Star Tour" of the night sky with an Astronomer. If there is remaining time because students were well mannered and timely, We can show the new James Webb Space Telescope Images. ***shows can be developed to fit school curriculum and age appropriate** 2 hour includes full park tour, hike, and observatory visit
