West 14th Street Rehabilitation Project

**Quigley Avenue to Fairfield Avenue
(City of Cleveland - Wards 3 & 12)**

Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue

CLEVELAND – Beginning Monday, April 5, 2021, ODOT will begin construction of the West 14th Street Resurfacing project. Maintenance of traffic will be as follows:

- Two-way traffic will be maintained northbound on West 14th Street from Quigley Avenue to Fairfield Avenue. Two southbound lanes will be closed.
- Once the work in southbound lanes is complete, the traffic will transfer to two-way southbound lanes. Two northbound lanes will be closed.

Access at all intersections and driveways will be maintained, but on-street parking will not be permitted.

Electronic message boards will be placed on either end of the construction prior to the week of April 5, 2021 informing the public of the impending construction work.

The West 14th construction is being administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation. Improvements include:

- The pavement resurfacing project on West 14th St. begins 400 feet north of Quigley Avenue to Fairfield Avenue approximately 0.9 miles.
- The existing asphalt surface will be removed, the underlying pavement base will be repaired and new asphalt will be placed in two courses.
- New thermoplastic pavement markings will be installed to replace existing pavement markings.
- All Recycled Materials to be used on project such as Asphalt, Concrete and Steel.

- 25 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps will be installed at crossing street locations.
- 1250 Feet of crosswalks will be installed at intersecting streets.
- 1.3 miles of bike lanes will be repainted on both sides of the street which support the Mayor's Bikeway Masterplan and improves the connectivity.

The work on this project will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The project will be completed by August 31, 2021.
