Here's what the food bank is doing:

-- Call Help Line at 216.738.2067

-- Packing emergency boxes with a seven-day supply of nonperishable food for households in need, including families and seniors.

- Reaching out to after-school meal partners to plan how to provide food for children while they're out of school and providing grab-and-go lunches.
- Providing weekend bags of food through the Backpacks for Kids program at 22 Cleveland schools. The program provides more than 3,500 children each week with a bag of food containing six meals for Saturdays and Sundays.
- Turning the monthly produce distribution (third Thursday, 4pm-6pm) into a drive-through pantry, where volunteers can put food into client's trunks. The food bank is also working on helping partner agencies do the same.
- Promoting calls to the Help Center for anyone in need of food. The food bank is tracking any changes at partner agencies and connecting callers to an open food site in their neighborhood.
