**NEW SEWER CONSTRUCTION
IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD**

Dear Resident:

The Sewer District has begun construction to reduce sewage overflows into the environment. The **West 3rd Quigley/Westerly (W3QW)** project includes underground sewer construction along Seymour and Castle Avenues, and a sewer separation project (resulting in separate storm and sanitary pipes) on West 3rd Street. W3QW construction began this month and is expected to be done in Spring 2022.

The W3QW project will reduce CSO (*see right*), providing improved water quality in Lake Erie for drinking water, boating, beachgoing, and other recreation.

The project is part of **Project Clean Lake**, a Sewer District program geared toward meeting Clean Water Act standards and addressing water-quality issues. This is a federally-mandated plan to reduce sewer overflows.

Construction will have some short-term impacts, including lane changes, noise, dust, dirt, and/or mud.

What is CSO?

“CSO” stands for *combined sewer overflow*. Cleveland’s earliest sewers are combined sewers. Built around the turn of the 19th century, these sewers carry sewage and stormwater in a single pipe.

During heavy rains, when there is a dramatic increase of water flowing through the sewers, some of the combined wastewater and stormwater is allowed to overflow into area waterways to prevent urban flooding. Combined sewer overflow harms our environment.

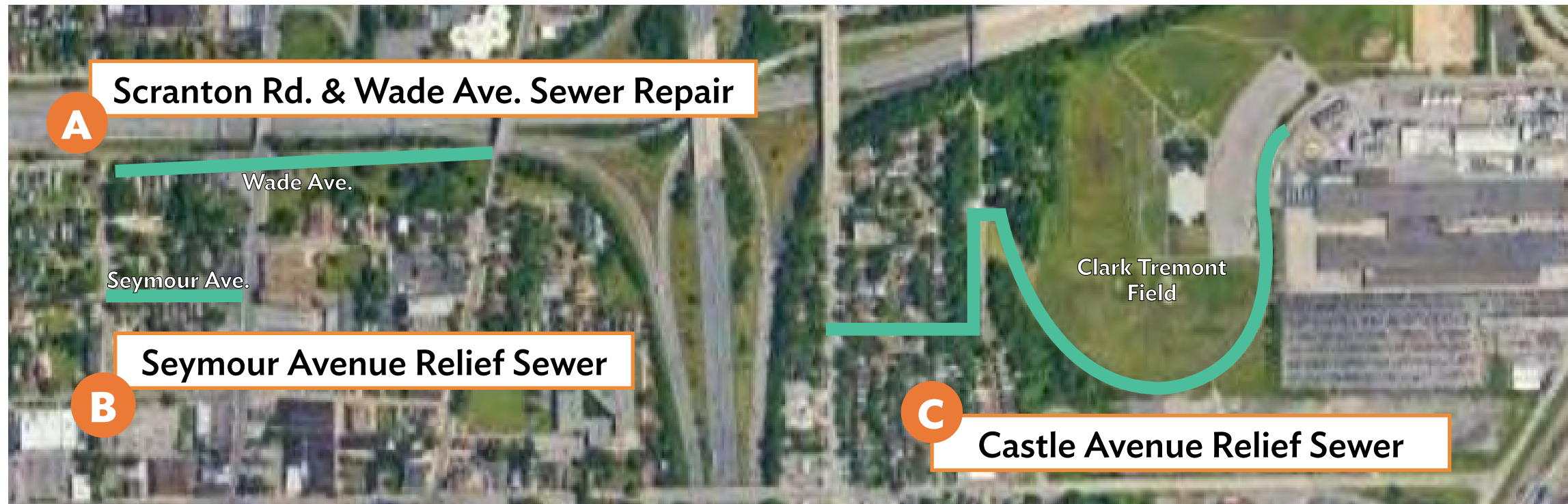

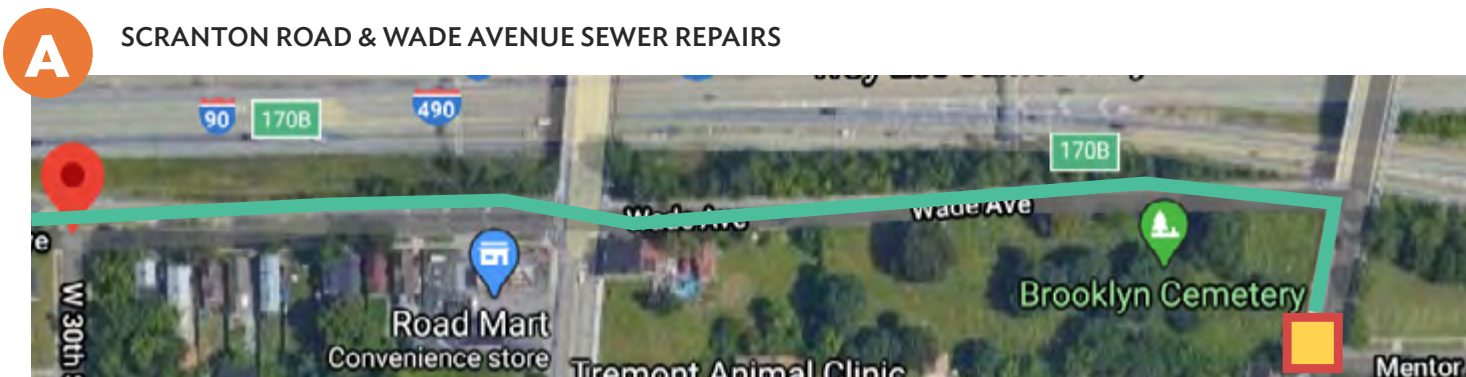


Construction duration September 2020 – April 2022

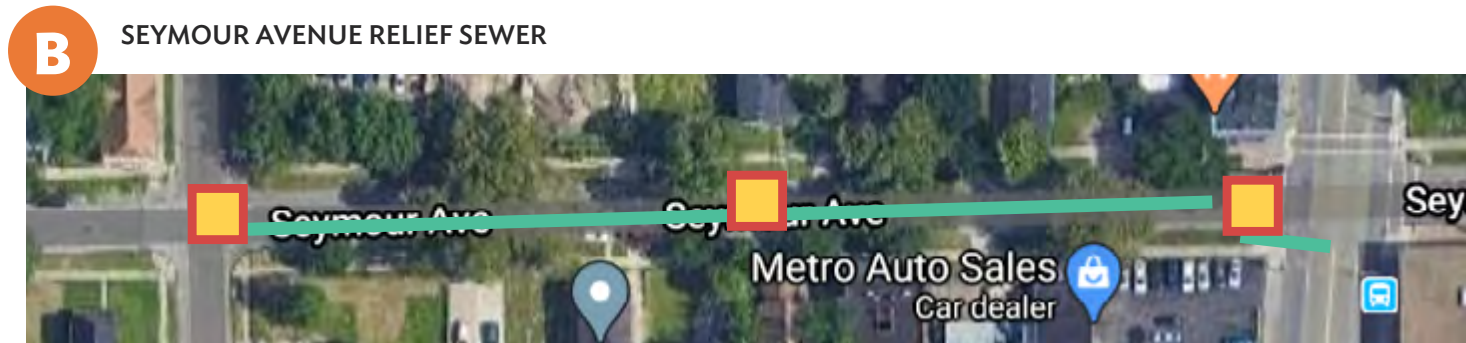
(Not all sites will be active for the entire project duration.)



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Underground repairs will occur below Wade Avenue. On Scranton Road, between Wade and Seymour Avenues, an existing regulator will be reconstructed. Traffic will be impacted, but will be maintained in at least one direction.



A small portion of West 30th at Seymour Ave. will have open-cut sewer construction. Underground construction will occur below Seymour between West 30th and West 25th. That portion of Seymour will have limited traffic access and street parking. Access to the Business Incubator at the corner of West 25th and Seymour, and access to residents' driveways, will be maintained.



There will be open-cut sewer construction along West 11th Street, as well as underground work along Castle Avenue between West 11th and West 14th Streets. Traffic will be impacted, with limited access on Castle Ave.
