You need to register online at: <http://ppl.ny11.READsquared.com> and contract to read at least 20 minutes a day, 5 days a week (children who are not yet reading can be read to). Once registered, you will also receive a special reading game bag with our official reading calendar, a fun interactive game board, paper dice, rules and official contract and other surprises!

You may log your minutes read each day online. Once you have fulfilled your contract, you will earn a "Puss and Boots" online badge. Each week you can play the game on your "at home game board". You get one roll of the dice to advance on the game board. For each week your contract is met, you earn an extra roll of the dice. And if you follow the special directions on certain game board spaces, you can earn special *Imagine Your Story* stickers. Come to Penfield Public Library once each week during curbside hours, and pick up an *Imagine Your Story* prize!
