MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

- The July 8, 2019, Vestry Meeting Minutes were approved as presented.

VESTRY GREETER REPORTS

- There were complaints that it was too cold in the church.

DISBURSING TREASURER and PROPERTY COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON

- After many years of service, Sam White is stepping down as Disbursing Treasurer.
- Allyson Heinold will be taking over the responsibilities of Disbursing Treasurer.
- John Handlin is stepping down as Property Committee Chairperson.
- Bob August is the new Chairperson of the Property Committee.
- The Vestry will prepare some type of recognition for all that Sam and John have done for St. James'.

FINANCIAL – Steve Prescott

Treasurer's Report

- There was nothing out of the ordinary in July.
- July Revenue \$ 9,985
- July Expenses -12,303
- July Deficit **-2,318**
- The 2019 deficit is now projected to be around \$10,000. It was originally projected to be \$31,000.

Stewardship

- Steve Prescott is willing to prepare the annual stewardship letter.
- He will have it ready to be reviewed at the September Vestry Meeting.

Tax Credits

- Once the bill for the new church roof has been paid, the Tax Credit process will begin.

PROPERTY – Edward Clark

Downstairs Back Door

- There is a problem with the lock on the back door downstairs.
- It can be unlocked but it can't be locked.
- Borden Adams will be notified about the problem.

MEMORIAL PLAQUES and CEMETERY – David Perry

Memorial Plaques

David Perry has been working on getting the memorial plaques current. He asked if the funds come from the Cemetery Fund or do the families pay for them? The families pay for the plaques.

Memorial Plaque in Parish House

- Five plaques have been added to the wooden memorial plaque.

Columbarium

- David Perry has been in touch with Cecil Vault about ordering two plaques and having them installed for the columbarium memorial.

Copper Cross

- There is a copper cross that Larry Heinold suggested attaching to a suitable base and placing the cross in the center of the circle in front of the church.
 - The Vestry discussed the suggestion. As the cross is copper, there is the risk that it could be stolen.
 - It was decided it would be best not to put the cross in the circle.

Cemetery Wall

- Some stones are falling out of the wall in the cemetery.
- David Niehaus had mentioned he could repair the wall.
 - David Perry will ask David N. if he would be willing to do the repairs.

- There will be a breakfast on Welcome Back Sunday.
 - The Education Group and members of the Vestry will provide the food.

History – David Perry

Communication – Jim Craig

- Members have been assigned weekends through the end of August.

 - They might have the Youth Group only meet twice a month.
