**TENTATIVE EXAMINATION SCHEDULE - JANUARY 2020**

**In-Class Final Exams – January 13, 14, and 15**

These exams will be given in class. Some exams will be one period in length; other exams may be given in parts over two days of class. Students will attend all classes as normal. No other exams or quizzes may be administered on these days. Teachers will take final exams into consideration as they assign homework.

**Two-Hour Final Examinations – January 16, 17, and 21**

All students must attend school on January 16 and 17. Exams will be given in the morning, from 8:05-10:25 AM, and in the afternoon, from 12:30-2:50 PM. In between, students will have lunch and a study period (or vice versa). Students who are eligible to receive extended time accommodations may finish morning examinations during the study period and afternoon examinations after school. Students will receive room assignments a few days before tests begin.

**Regents Examinations – January 21 to January 23**

Students will receive individualized Regents Exam passes on January 15. During Regents Week, students will only report to school if they are scheduled to take an examination. **Weather Cancellations and Delays**

Cancellations and delays are announced by the Department of Education. Check the DOE website or listen to the news to find out if school is canceled or delayed.

- If school is canceled on a final exam day, the exams that would have been given on that day will instead be administered on the next day. We will schedule a make-up date in February for the second day of exams.
- If a significant delay is announced, report at the new time announced by the Department of Education. Morning final exams will instead be administered in the afternoon. We will schedule a make-up date in February for the afternoon exams.
- If no delay is announced, we will proceed with final exams as originally scheduled. We may adjust the schedule in order to accommodate lateness due to transportation delays.
- Regents Exams may NOT be re-scheduled. If the DOE cancels school on the date of a Regents Exam, you will take it in June unless otherwise announced by the Department of Education. If there is no cancellation, you must take the Regents Exam on the exact date and at the exact time specified on your exam pass.

**Important Note**

Students must follow all testing rules during examinations. Cell phones and other electronic devices are NOT permitted in the testing rooms. You are also prohibited from bringing into the testing rooms or consulting any other materials that may be of assistance during your exams. Possession or use of an electronic device (even if off) or of any other prohibited material, or failure to follow any testing rules, may invalidate your final exam or Regents Exam mark.

**First Day of the Spring Semester – January 28**

On Tuesday, January 28, students must report to school at 8:00 AM. You will receive your spring semester program and attend a full day of classes. Please note that Lehman College classes begin on Monday, January 27, or Tuesday, January 28. You will be notified if you are registered to take a college class.
