



CCP- To Note in December

The Continuing Competence Program ([CCP](#)) is a regulatory requirement that supports nurses, as self-regulated professionals, in examining their accountability to their practice. The CCP is a prospective process, which means that in December a self-assessment of your nursing practice against the standards of practice to determine your learning needs (step 1), and the preparation of your learning plan for the upcoming practice year (step 2) should be completed.
