



The Nurses Association of New Brunswick (NANB) offers a Preauthorized Debit (PAD) Program which permits members to prepay their annual renewal fees for the upcoming year in monthly installments. Participation in the program is voluntary.

**For RNs, NANB will debit the member's account for the amount of \$66.18 on the fifteenth day of the month, with the first payment being withdrawn from your bank account on January 15th.** If the fifteenth day of the month falls on a weekend or holiday, the member's account will be debited on the next business day. Please note that your final payment in August will be \$66.19, to account for the final remaining amount of your registration fees.

**For NPs, NANB will debit the member's account for the amount of \$79.33** (which covers the additional CNPS fees associated with your practice). Please note that your final payment in August will be \$79.37 to account for the final remaining amount of your registration fees.

These withdrawal totals include a one-time \$20 administration fee for the year. This fee is non-refundable.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

By signing up with NANB's PAD program, you acknowledge the following:

- That you wish to participate in the New Brunswick Nurses Association (NANB) Preauthorized Debit (PAD) Program.
- That you authorize NANB and your financial institution to begin monthly deductions for your annual fees for the upcoming renewal year. The total fees collected will be equal to your annual renewal fees for the upcoming year plus the \$20 administration fee.
- The NANB PAD program exists for members who do not already participate in an employer deduction program. If you pay into deductions with your employer for your registration fees, you should not sign up for NANB's PAD program, as there is no need to sign up for both.
- A member may withdraw from the PAD program at any time by notifying NANB by email at [NANBregistration@nanb.nb.ca](mailto:NANBregistration@nanb.nb.ca).
- Members will be charged a fee of \$30 for any payments that are rejected for insufficient funds (NSF). If you miss a monthly payment, you will need to pay the missing amount by credit card online while completing your renewal in October or November.
- A member will be deemed ineligible for continued participation in the PAD program if their monthly payment is rejected for insufficient funds more than once in a 24- month period.
