\* **Jeffco:**

- More than 35,000 immigrants call Jefferson County home, making up 6% of the county's population and working in jobs that span the wage spectrum.
- Immigrants make up 7% of Jefferson County's workforce, and immigrant labor power generates GDP in industries across the County's economy.
- In addition to their contributions as workers, immigrants make up 8% of business owners in Jefferson County.
- Immigrants in Jefferson County pay over \$413 million in tax revenue and hold \$1.1 billion spending power.
