

IFCS has been designated an Emergency Food Provider First Responder for the Metro Denver area. Where clients were able to enter the building for foodstuffs, this is no longer available due to COVID19. Instead ,a drive-up distribution is needed. Distributions are made 5 days a week from 8:30-11:30 and 1:00-3:00. There is no Wed. afternoon distribution at this time.

Volunteers (6 per week) are needed to greet clients,check for reservation, confirm the number of adults, children who need food in the family and demographics. A volunteer would then pick up the box of food, from a conveyor belt, place the box in the trunk or backseat of the vehicle and the client drives off.

Volunteers:

- Commit to one Wed. a month (Sept./Oct.)
- Work from 8:00 -noon
- Be able and willing to work outside in elements
- Stand for the duration of the volunteer event (shelter tents provided)
- Complete a health screen survey waiver, temperature check
