At its core, data science is computation with context. It is a mathematics discipline rooted in its interconnectivity to other subjects. A data science curriculum bridges the gap between statistical acumen, software engineering, and domain expertise. Approved applicants (25) will engage in three days of professional learning during the Summer 2022 and three follow-up virtual meetings during the 2022-2023 academic year.
