What Are the Phases of Virginia's Covid-19 Immunization Campaign?

The [Virginia Department of Health \(VDH\)](#) has announced three Initial Phases: **1A**, **1B**, and **1C**. **So far vaccines are being offered under 1A and 1B only.** Vaccine supplies are limited and will vary across regions of the state. See the VDH website for information on the immunization of essential workers. Not covered here.

Phase 1A - Who Was First?

Virginia's immunization campaign began December 14, 2020 with **Phase 1A** for front-line health care personnel, including direct care aides and home health workers, plus residents and staff of long term care facilities, intermediate care facilities, and adult care homes, family care homes, and group homes. **Phase 1A is ongoing.**

How to Register for a Vaccination in Phase 1B?

Starting January 18th Phase 1B is open. Complete the applicable survey(s) below to notify VDH of your interest in being immunized in Phase 1B.
