Hypocritical Bonin Hires Private Security to Protect His Westchester Office from a Homeless Encampment, But Votes Against Protecting Schools & Children



Westside Los Angeles (CA) – Councilmember Mike Bonin hired a private security firm to keep his district office safe from crime associated with a homeless encampment located outside the door. The disclosure by the [Westside Current](#) of this expenditure to protect his safety comes on the heels of Bonin’s vote against enforcing the no-camping ordinance within 500 feet of schools.

“Mike Bonin’s latest flip flop is another example of his hypocrisy and how out of touch he is on homelessness and the unlawful encampments that have overtaken large portions of the Westside,” said Craig Lally, President of the Los Angeles Police Protective League. “In one breath, Bonin tells the public that enforcement is not the answer to homeless camps, and in the next breath, he pays for private security to protect his office from individuals camping outside his Westchester office.
