Notice of Race

2020 Ted Janeway Memorial Regatta
September 19, 2020

Organizing Authority:

Cold Spring Harbor Beach Club (CSHBC) and the Atlantic Class Association (ACA)

1.0 Rules:

The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 Including the prescriptions of United States Sailing Association, the Rules of the Atlantic Class Association, and this Notice of Race (except as any of these may be modified by the Sailing Instructions). Handheld VHF radios are required. The R/C will broadcast Venue, Course, and Race information on Channel 78.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

Eligibility is limited to Atlantic owners in good standing and charter skippers whose charters are in conformance with Class Rules, sailing Atlantic Class yachts which meet Class rules and certification requirements, and who have completed accepted entries. Participating yachts must be covered by a current liability insurance policy of at least \$300,000. Qualified yachts may enter by e-mailing entry info (Sail number, yacht name, hull color, skipper's full name, cell phone, yacht club) to gnlindsayjr@gmail.com The deadline for entry is Thursday, September 17, 2020.

3.0 FEES:

There is no fee for entry to the 2020 Regatta.

4.0 SCHEDULE:

Racing will take place on September 19, 2020, with the possibility (if enough participants agree) to postpone to Sunday, September 20, if weather forces a change. Fleet captains will check in by phone at 8:00 am to confirm weather details, participants, and meeting location. The first warning will be signaled at 1100 hours, or as soon as the fleets convene in the starting area.

Up to three races will be run, depending upon conditions. One completed race will qualify the series. No race will be started later than 1500 hours.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing Instructions will be emailed to all entrants on 9/17/2020.

6.0 VENUE:

The racing area will be in Long Island Sound waters South and West of Sheffield Island, or nearby, as conditions permit. Please follow and keep track of the Signal Boat and monitor Channel 78.

7.0 THE COURSES:

The courses will be windward-leeward for a specified number of legs.

8.0 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

The CSHBC Race Committee will be on VHF Channel 78.

9.0 PRIZES:

The Ted Janeway series trophy will be awarded to the winner of the series at the Atlantic Class Annual Meeting.
