

PARISH REOPENING UPDATES

Updates as of July 4, 2021

- For those who wish to receive Communion on the tongue at Mass, please be last in Father's line, as he will sanitize in between each tongue communicant.
- The Parish Office is open to the public Monday-Friday, 8:00 am-5:00 pm (Update - The office is no longer closed for lunch.). Items can also be left in office mailbox.
- The Adoration Chapel (located in the Pastoral Office) has reopened. Hours: 8:00 am-4:30 pm. All are welcome to attend a Holy Hour of Devotion weekdays at 3:00 pm beginning Wednesday, July 7. In-person or Online. Live streamed on Facebook @StLukeParishTC, on Youtube.com (Channel: Fr. Robert Victoria) and via Twitter @fsvic3.

Ongoing:

- For those who are vaccinated, masks and physical distancing are no longer required on parish property for Mass, in the Adoration Chapel, during Drive-thru Confessions, or visiting the Pastoral Office. Masks will continue to be required for those who are unvaccinated and cannot physically distance from those not in your household.

We ask that everyone respects the comfortability and vulnerabilities of our fellow parishioners as we transition out of the Pandemic and respect their decisions to continue mask wearing and distancing.

- Music Issues and Missalettes will return to the church pews and not to be taken home, but shared at liturgies (*It is not necessary to return the old missalettes you may have; please recycle or save for when the recycling bin is on the church property July 9-11.*)
- Liturgical singing is allowed.
- The choir loft is not available for seating at this time.
- The 10:30 am Sunday Mass will continue to be live streamed for now. The Mass is available to view on the St. Luke Church website (www.stluketemplecity.org), on the St. Luke Church Vimeo webpage (<https://vimeo.com/stluketemplecity>), and the St. Luke Catholic School Facebook page (St. Luke Catholic School Temple City). The live stream can be replayed.
- For now, all employees and volunteers are required to wear masks during liturgies, which means that as you see priests and ministers following protocol, it is due to Archdiocesan policy and CalOSHA standards which we are mandated to comply to.
- Reminder! The Drive-thru Communion Reception Line has been discontinued.
- Drive-thru Confessions are held outdoors on Saturdays at 10:00 am, weather permitting. Drive through the church parking lot where you will be directed through the back alley to approach one of the priests who will hear your brief confession from outside the passenger side of the car. If there are multiple people in the car, the passenger/s may exit and stand at a safe distance and we will come to them after hearing the driver's confession. Drive out safely the rear gate onto Live Oak Avenue.
- For anointing of the sick and other sacramental arrangements, please call the Pastoral Office.
- Groups/ministry meetings are not allowed to meet on campus. Please do not meet off campus.

Archbishop Gomez has rescinded the dispensation for attending Mass. Those with vulnerabilities or underlying conditions may wish to stay home. Please do not attend Mass if you are sick or not feeling well.

Speak Out Against Doctor-Assisted Suicide

With doctor-assisted suicide being legal in California for only a few years, proponents say the law is working and now want to eliminate important “safeguards” and reduce the “trial-period” they initially said were needed to help protect Californians from abuse and misuse of the law. The move follows the usual path of physician-assisted suicide laws in other states and nations – promise protections and limits, then gradually strip those away:

Specifically, SB 380 (Eggman, D-Stockton) would roll back the following 2015 “safeguards”:

- Change the current 15-day waiting period for lethal drugs to 48 hours and drop the patient attestation.
- Prematurely ends the existing 2026 sunset date and legislative reevaluation option four years early with little to no scientific data to support this action (especially in light of the worldwide pandemic).
- No future Legislative review or evaluation of annual reports about assisted suicide requests and their outcomes.

Proponents of the physician-assisted suicide (PAS) law touted the fact that California’s law had strong protections when it passed inappropriately during a special legislative session called to look at Medi-Cal funding six years ago. Now, those “safeguards” could be eliminated. In fact, during the first committee oversight hearing to extend the law, proponents even brought up the “need” to let more minorities know of the law’s existence, bemoaning the fact that minorities were not using the law. Sadly, Medi-Cal still does not have sufficient palliative care funding to ensure recipients receive adequate end-of-life care and are not subtly encouraged to take their lives.

This law was implemented in 2016 with very specific requirements and with proponents promising sound decision-making and information gathering to provide the science to evaluate the law’s impact. Yet now, after only four years and only three very inconclusive reports by the California Department of Public Health, they say the state should end the current 2025 sunset date and legislative reevaluation option now.

On July 6, SB 380 will be heard in the Assembly Judiciary Committee. Your voice is important! The California Catholic Conference of Bishops encourages us to contact our California elected representative TODAY and strongly urge a NO vote on SB 380.

On this Independence Day, we are reminded of the words of Thomas Jefferson, “*We hold these truths to be self-evident: that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.*”

What has happened to the right to life? Why, after so many deaths during the pandemic and rates of depression skyrocketing, do we need to encourage more death now? Speak out against doctor-assisted suicide!
