1. Updates on Graduate School Dean Search - Rene and Steve *There are five finalists. The first one was yesterday. An external candidate is going to be on Thursday. Then three more next week.*
2. Mathematica renewal - Mikel *We decided to not renew this year. Do more of an a la carte approach. 10 teacher and 50 student seats. Negotiations are currently in the contract phase in Jaggaer and won't be complete before the previous license expires. Mikel is working to see if we can get a grace period so there won't be any interruptions of service. Stay tuned.*
3. PREP Grant - Dustin Internal grant mechanisms - *This is a remodeled internal grant mechanism the spring - goal is to promote collaborations that will lead to major grants. Announcement will be coming soon.*
4. Advancement Priorities by Department (One added question): *Chairs were asked to revisit that survey to add the added question and/or modify and add other needs.*
