We are pleased and excited to extend an invitation to any female student in the 6th to 10th grade to attend the Inquire! Innovate! Invent! Day which will be held at The University of Akron on Saturday, October 21st, 2017! At this event, we strive to give students the necessary knowledge, self-confidence and motivation to pursue a career in the exciting and diverse field of engineering while also giving them a first-hand look the creativity involved in innovation and inventing at The University of Akron.

The program is designed to teach girls how the innovations of women have impacted many lives and how they can become innovators and inventors themselves. Check-in and breakfast begins at 8 a.m. and the program runs from 8:30 a.m. until 2 p.m. with lunch included. This is an opportunity to talk to female engineers and scientists, meet inventors, learn about patent law, explore careers in research and development, and explore the creative side of innovation while working hand in hand with science and getting the opportunity to participate in fun, creative, design and build activities. Participants will also do a service project that will help younger girls learn about science and engineering. All participants will receive a bag and a fun patch. A light breakfast and lunch are included in the day's events. The program is held at the Student Union at The University of Akron. The cost is \$20 for each child and \$9 for each adult and registration is limited and often closes prior to the registration deadline. We have space for 300 girls and will consider a scholarship for any student who demonstrates financial need. If you know of such a student or students, we ask that a school administrator contact us directly to arrange aid.

We ask for your support in encouraging exceptional and deserving young ladies who may be interested in this opportunity. Enclosed is the form necessary for parents/guardians and potential participants to complete. Please make as many copies of the enclosed form as needed to distribute to interested students.
