Q&A

1. Can my child join the Taipei Camp but not stay at the Hotel Accommodation provided?

Families may stay in their own accommodations; please choose Package A. Please note that if you are not staying at the same hotel as SWAN, morning transportation will not be provided. Parents are responsible for drop-off and pick-up.

2. Who is eligible to join the Taipei Camp?

All SWAN and non-SWAN students who are Level 2 or above in Chinese are eligible register. Please note that a language assessment is required for all SWAN and non-SWAN participants prior to acceptance into the program.

3. What if I only want my child to join the Taipei Camp and not the Saturday activity?

Kindly note Saturday Activity is within the package B & C and will not be prorated. But if you decide not to join, please do let us know.

4. Can I check out of the Hotel a day earlier?

Yes, please let us know at time of registration, kindly note that package fee will not be prorated.

5. How will the students travel to and from the Taipei Camp?

There will be a transportation available to transport the students camp every morning (the transportation is for students and SWAN staff, not for parents).

6. Is a Taiwan Visa required to travel to Taiwan?

U.S citizens are visa exempt for up to 90 days. Passports must have at least 6 months of validity from the date of entry. Visitors must fill out the [Immigration Arrival Card](#) before arriving in Taiwan.
