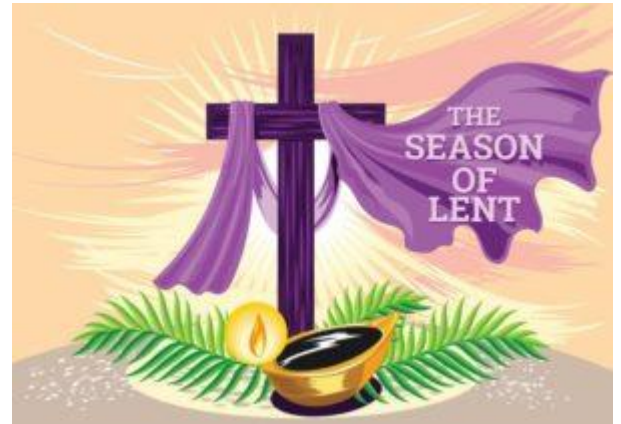
## March at St. Paul's

### March 28 – Maundy Thursday

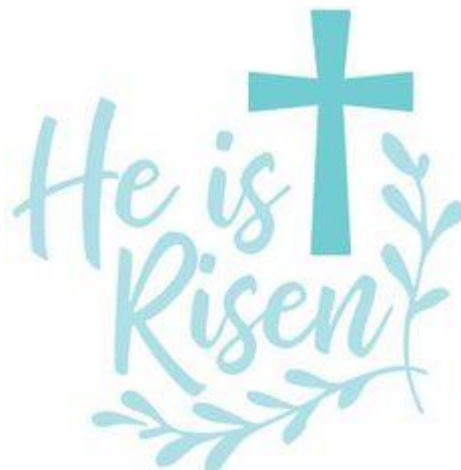
- Holy Eucharist at 5:30 pm in the church.
