Annual Meeting Election Time

The process for selecting our next senior warden, vestry members, and 2022 Diocesan Council delegates has now started with the formation of the Nominating Committee. Three delegates and one alternate delegate must be chosen for the 2022 council. With the expiration of the term of Senior Warden Helen Pridmore and four vestry persons, the January church Annual Meeting will elect a senior warden for a two-year term from 2021-2023 and the vestry persons for a three-year term from 2021-2024.

The outgoing vestry persons, Mary Ann Hardy, Dawn Barham, Richard Thomas, and Leigh Yarborough, together with the committee chair, outgoing Senior Warden Helen Pridmore, and at-large members Jennet Lacey and Rose Crowe will propose a slate of nominees for election. Recommendations from church members will be vetted and proposed based on the need for a well-rounded vestry representing all views of the congregation. We will consider leadership traits, faithful service to St. Paul's, and faithful support of the church. The slate will be published by Dec. 4.

The first step in this process is for the Nominating Committee to receive recommendations. Please prayerfully consider your recommendations, place them in a sealed envelope, and give them to Lori in the church office, noting the position you are recommending they fill. (Please do not ask that person to serve or use any other means to tip them off that you have recommended them to the committee.) The committee will ask the nominee to serve. Recommendations can be made until November 18.

The final slate with short biographical information will be published before the annual meeting in January. Between December 4 and December 20, additional nominations with the permission of the nominee and with a written biography will be received.
