Put your imagination to the test!



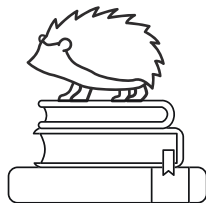
Tweens can join Felicia and build creations with Lego, or join Justin and begin a RPG journey with friends!
