

EXHIBIT A

Approved and Prohibited Plant Species

- A. It is recommended that Unit Owners utilize local nurseries, landscape services, contractors, or landscape architects who have certified horticulturists or arborists on staff for plant species selection, installation, and maintenance.
 - 1. Take into consideration sun/shade exposure, type of soils (especially regarding soil drainage), slope of site and proximity to streets, sidewalks, structures, solar panels, etc.
 - 2. If applicable, inform adjacent unit owner of proposed plantings.
