In fact, when I was gathering people to serve on the Evangelism team, I had to do some explaining to quiet those fears. I like what Pastor Steve said at our last meeting, "Evangelism is relationships!" How simple, how freeing! Taking it a step further, relationships are not under the jurisdiction of one committee. Relationships are the whole congregations responsibility. It is the committee's mission to give the congregation the tools to forge relationships.




