

## Revised Guidelines for In-Person Worship as of 7/12/2021

Maintain 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. worship services. Continue live streaming of both services.

No limit to number of people in sanctuary. Remove social distancing tape from pews. Keep first three pews on pulpit side and first pew on organist side reserved for people participating in services. Keep pew in front of AV booth empty as well.

Individuals who have not been fully vaccinated or are at high risk are still required to wear a face mask and to maintain social distances.

Ushers and greeters should remind people to wear a face mask and to maintain social distancing if not fully vaccinated or are high risk individuals.

Eliminate overflow seating in the Christian Education Building.

Cease contact tracing.

Continue to provide hand sanitizer stations.

Return Holy Bibles and hymnals to pews after Vacation Bible School.

Include normal “friendship” sheet in bulletins.

Continue with no Passing of the Peace and no coffee hour. Microphone should not be passed for prayer requests during contemporary service.

Provide childcare and nursery during VBS, if needed. Provide digital thermometer for use in cases where a child appears unwell.

Resume nursery during Sunday morning worship services, if needed.

Continue use of individual communion kits until further notice.

Continue use of giving stations until further notice.

Encourage congregating outside rather than inside the church.

Eliminate sanitizing sanctuary and common touch areas between services.
