- The site of the a prominent hotel in the early 1800s through early 1900s,, and hear from one of the people who lived enslaved at the hotel
- The site of a restaurant owned by two enslaved black men
- Two of the participants will be able to step into the persona of two people who lived enslaved in the city and made significant contributions to the city and state
- The site of property owned by a Black woman and her husband
- The Jefferson City National Cemetery where Michelle Brooks. author of the "The Jefferson City Civil Pilots: From Lincoln University to Tuskegee Airmen". There we will hear from Michelle about the Lincoln University founders and other Black people of Jefferson City interred at the National Cemetery and Jefferson City's Woodland Old City Cemetery
