Drug endangered children are part of a growing population of children whose lives have been seriously and negatively impacted by dangerous drugs. This training will look at overcoming the challenges in aligning the agencies and systems responsible for preventing, intervening, and treating issues related to drug endangered children. The training will also focus on how to implement the Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Approach, which has been proven to be effective in increasing the chances of better outcomes for drug endangered children and break multi-generational cycles of abuse and neglect. Insights about how various professionals are in a position to identify, protect, and serve drug endangered children and their families will be provided.

Lieutenant (retired) Eric Nation began his career in law enforcement in 1994 where he held numerous positions. He is a Certified Core DEC Instructor that has been involved in the training of thousands of professionals across the United States as a Trainer for the National Alliance for Drug Endangered Children.

Stacey Read is the Director of DEC Network Development and has spent over 16 years working in the child welfare field gaining insight and experience on a variety of key child welfare issues. Stacey has trained thousands of professionals on topics involving child welfare issues, collaboration and multidisciplinary teams, evidence/information collection, local alliance development, and other specific drug issues.
