This training covers the nine competencies set forth in the NCA standards and will include evaluation of an increase in skills and knowledge in those attending the training.

This training is appropriate for advocates with less than five (5) years of experience who take part in providing the constellation of services to children served by a children's advocacy center (CAC) across the country. This includes victim advocates employed by the CAC, working at a partnering District Attorney's office, and/or staff of a community-based organization.
