You can help find support for victims of human trafficking right in our own community. By identifying pro-bono attorneys to assist these survivors, we can give them a path towards freedom and hope. Victims of human trafficking are eligible for a T-Visa, which will allow them to stay in the country legally, but without a lawyer, these visas are rarely obtained.

Oftentimes these victims are deported before they have the chance to see an attorney. Access to an attorney is essential for ending the further victimization of victims of human trafficking through detention and eventual deportation.
