Dear Administrator Farris:

On November 1<sup>st</sup> we received the email notice that the Division of Animal Industries was planning two workshops for NAC 571. These workshops were announced to take place in Winnemucca on November 16<sup>th</sup> at 1 p.m. and in Elko on November 17<sup>th</sup> at 11 a.m.

The Nevada Farm Bureau Federation wishes to formally request that additional workshop locations be included for more complete participation by impacted livestock owners. Given the scope and significance of the proposed regulations there should be a complete and comprehensive ability for producers around the state participate through in-person workshops. We believe that adding a workshop in Fallon, in Tonopah and in Ely (beyond the announced sites in Winnemucca and Elko) would provide coverage of the state with reasonable travel distances for livestock producers in other areas of Nevada.

We have been reviewing the proposed package of the regulatory changes being presented and will have further request for clarification and our formalized statements to make when we attend the workshop sessions.

Thank you in advance for consideration of our request for these additional workshop sites.
